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### **Project Description**

"A paradigm shift in how we feel and perform at work" was the vision for the new premises for Southern Cross Healthcare. To complement the look and feel of Warren & Mahoney's design Precision created customised furniture and storage solutions. Custom door post colours on the Smartstores enabled the furniture to be part of the interior palette of accent colours used throughout the floors. Credenzas were designed with custom door, drawer and height to work seamlessly with workstations from suppliers. The resulting challenge with very successful results for our design team. An exciting new addition to our range Strata Park, an integrated planting/seating system, was further enhanced with voids created as spaces for magazines.

With the furniture designed and manufactured, the next phase was the installation. Programmed over two stages from February to April, deliveries and installation were coordinated and managed with our contractors and project manager adhering to all the on site Health and Safety procedures. Tight time slots for lift use to install furniture over the three floors required a high level of communication and detailed negotiations, but timings were achieved with a successful result.
